

MEASURING AN EXISTING RING

If you already have a ring that is the perfect fit, this is an easy way to find your ring size.

Before you start, print this sizing chart in A4 size and scaled to 100%. You can check the accuracy of the print by positioning a credit card on the line shown; if the card lines up, you're all set!

Select an existing ring that's a good fit for the desired finger. If possible, choose a ring that has a similar width band, as a wider band will typically need to be one size larger than a narrow band.

Match the inside of that ring with one of the circles on the sizing chart. When your ring has been placed on the right ring size, you should see only the green circle inside your ring, with no white space showing. If your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.

Please also consider the size of the knuckle when selecting a size.

Does the design of the ring make a difference? Yes, it can. For example, a wide ring typically needs to be a larger size than a narrow one. Therefore, we recommend that you order one size larger than you would for a single narrow ring.
